# RMNC Meeting Minutes 3-26-08

## Page 1

### Meeting to order 7:30pm - 19 Members attending - **1 NEW Member - Mike Doran**

Dan addressed the membership and asked the New Member to introduce himself. Mike Doran, who worked for Rick and Jan Ellinger at their Service Station in Boulder when he was in high school, has among all his cars a 1973 Nova SS. Dan introduced the Officers to the new member.

Jan gave the treasurers report, said that there were 29 pre registered entrants, and that it was about that same number this time last year. Dan said he has emailed those who have not paid their member dues; also Eric Salazar is no longer a member, he moved to Texas after his school was over.

Dan brought up Name badges and that we have badges for those that have not paid their member dues. The club will have to eat the costs. It was agreed that any order for clothes, etc. from here on out must be paid for up front.

Tom Koehler talked about the car show and passed out a packet to the members. He and Dan are very pleased with the Artwork Design on the T-shirts and Jerry Potts Plaques. Tom showed a shirt that had sponsors artwork on the back of the shirts, which would give the sponsors more incentive to sponsor plaques etc. The artwork would be an additional \$125. and based on 250 shirts, would cost only \$. 50 more per shirt. This for next year! Tom said he would be getting the plaques on April 11, and the Shirts on April 18th.

Tom said that Heritage Square will not come down on the \$200 for the use of the building for Car Show central. We will be getting the Metal Masters building in the center of the square. They have moved across the street.

Rick asked since Notz Landing was closed, what food arrangements are there? The Garden Grill is open, but probably will not be able to cover the load. Kiddieland will be setting up grills to do hamburgers, hot dogs etc.

A discussion ensued concerning Heritage square and our future there. People talked about other sites and the problems and costs that will change from what we have now. Kathy asked that we table the discussion until the June meeting, and get back to business. Dan asked how we came up with the Best of Nova award. It was decided at the Car Show committee meeting. Go Chevrolet will decide what Non-Member Nova will receive the award, RMNC will sponsor the award. Tom said the plaque size will be 9x12 for the Go Chevrolet Awards, Best Nova, and (2) Best of Shows, all others will be 8x10. A-1 Trophy will do the dash plaques with a \$15 setup and \$.99 ea. Cost. They are happy with whatever business we give them. Also Jerry Potts will donate two Award Clocks for the Best of Show Cars at his expense, and won't charge a setup fee for his work.

The walk-through for Heritage Square will be **April 13th** at noon; we will meet at the RTD Park-n-Ride at I-70 and Ward Rd at 11:15am. We will be meeting the new maintenance person Scott. Between Jim Hyatt and the Club we believe he understands how we will do things to avoid the problems from last year.

Dan and James Taylor will be doing the **Toy's for Tots**, Raffling off a Flamed Mailbox and T-shirts etc. Jan said she received a THANK YOU from the Toys for Tots foundation just a couple of weeks ago for last year's donation we made.

WE NEED MORE DOOR PRIZES. Tom said he has received bags from Haggerty and other stuff for the goody bags. **APRIL 27TH** at **1:00pm** at Tom's house will be the Goodie Bag Stuffing party! More to come!

Right now we have **42 Sponsors!**

Dan has secured 5 Judges, and Tom will be getting some through Felix and others. Tom believes we need 2 per class. We have 8 classes, but a couple can be combined. He has made the Judging sheets very simple. It was asked if we need a Judges meeting. YES! So we can assign Judges to the classes and get everyone on the same page. Jim Van Coevern asked if we pay the Judges? They get a T-Shirt and will be invited to the Car Show Workers dinner after the show. Tom said that original and early modified were the biggest classes. ALSO Plan B, if we come up short on Judges for whatever reason, Members of the club will be called on to do Judging. Tom Surveyed 29 people from last years show and said they liked the judging. Tom said there were no complaints from anyone he talked with.
