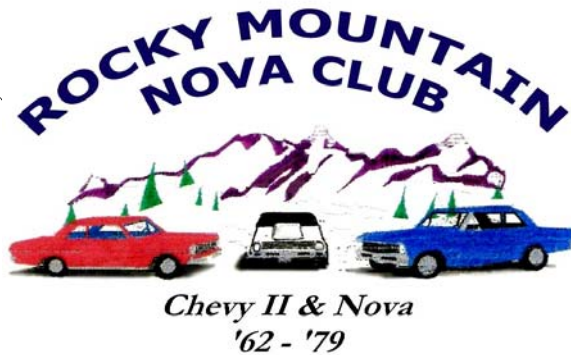
Musical at the Heritage Square Music Hall.
