Car Show Meeting At Arapahoe Park On March 7th

After breakfast at the Ralston Cafe 17 members went to Arapahoe Park to address laying out the park for the Car Show. For those that weren't there the park is a rectangle, the long part is north and south. 44th Ave is on the south side and Indiana is on the west side. The Park has a fence around it the entrance is on the west side about half way north from 44th on Indiana. The paved parking is L shaped that is on the southwest side of the park, starting at the entrance going south and then proceeding east for about three quarters of the width of the park. There is a cushion of grass and trees between the fences and the paved parking. There is a baseball diamond in the 90 degree angle of the paved parking and another one on the northwest part of the park. The brick restroom is just north of the L shaped parking lot. Dan had spent a lot of time with a measuring wheel at the park before Saturday. He had aerial views on 8 1/2 x 11 papers and passed them out to those there. With his measurements he put rows of cars running north and south on the grass. It was decided that we would fill the area east of the south baseball diamond first then work between the diamonds west to east in the pattern that Dan had laid out. It was also decided that to prevent the cars from building up out side

the park that we would park them first then have them go to the registration table and pick up their preregistered bags or get registered. About second base on the south diamond would be the stage where Scott the disc jockey would be. On either side would be the Best of Shows from last year and Dick Matthies Nova which is on the Artwork. The Reaction Light will be near the stage. The Gates will be closed at 10:00am. Vendors will be on north side against the Fence of the south part of the L shaped paved parking. For food so far we have two vendors doing Barbecue, a Hot Dog vendor, and a Subway vendor. REMEMBER if you have a vendor that wants to do our show PLEASE clear it with TOM KOEHLER first. The workers will park on the north side of the L shaped paved parking. We need tables and EZ up canopies. Let Tom know if you can bring either to get a count. Dan will check with Bryan at the park to make sure the sprinklers are off for Saturday and Sunday. On Saturday May 2nd at 10:00am we will gather at the park and use grass friendly paint to lay out the lines for parking the Cars. If you can volunteer to help please let Dan Pace know. Tom has the worker sheet for Sunday. TOM KOEHLER said the Artwork has been corrected. We also worked on the T-Shirt count. The

workers will get a shirt, Also each Judge will get a shirt. We counted the extra shirts Members wanted at cost. Last year we had 82 pre registered Tom had done a projection of cost with 225 shirts on his agenda sheet for the day. We decided to go with the 225 count. The DEADLINE for the sponsors for the plaques is APRIL 3rd so Tom can have the weekend to decide what sizes for the Categories, then give the order to Jerry Potts on Monday April 6th. Jerry will also do our magnetic dash plaques and it was decided on square instead of rectangular. We also have to give a Refundable Deposit of \$200 for the park. We will have to Police the park for trash after the show. The Next Car Show committee meeting will be April 18th, 230pm at Perkins just west of I-25 on 120th Ave. There will be a Judges meeting on April 19th at Perkins at 230pm, on I-25 & 120th Ave.
