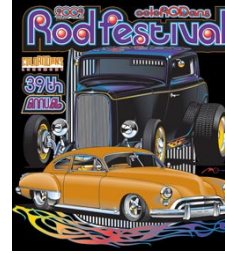

WE have our own **Rocky Chapter Newsletter** which we distribute monthly to our members.
