HOW TO CLASSIFY YOUR VEHICLE

Original & Restored 2 Classes 1900 to 1968 and 1969 to 1990

This Class will include vehicles that appear to be factory stock. The interior must be original or a duplicate of the original in material, style and color. Engine must be visibly stock for the vehicle's year and model. Numbers do not have to match. No tube-type headers allowed unless proved by original car manufactures.. No bolt-on aftermarket parts allowed. Wheels must be available for the year/model of the vehicle. All vehicles with a dealer conversion or factory conversion not installed at the factory (such as Yenko, SLP, etc.) will be moved to Modified class of the appropriate category.

Street Rods 2 Classes 1900 to 1932 and 1933 to 1949

Any car that has been modified in these years will be considered a Street Rod. Including T-buckets.

Modified 2 Classes 1950 to 1968 and 1969 to 1990

All vehicles with bolt-on aftermarket or dealer-installed parts and/or accessories. The body may have bolt-on spoilers, ground effects, fiberglass parts, etc. Paint may be of any color from any OEM manufacturer. Aftermarket candy, pearl, metal flake paint entries. Painted pinstripes, and taped pinstripes or decals, and vinyl graphics are allowed. Other items that move an entry to Modified Class include bolt-on headers, ignition wires, air cleaners, valve covers, continental kits, painted engine compartment, etc. Any aftermarket, non stock OEM, multiple carb set-ups, tunnel rams, blowers, turbo chargers and/or late model tuned port-type fuel injection on any other era vehicle. Interiors that are of a custom design that consists of changes to three or more of the following: seats, door panels, dash modifications, flooring, headliner, trunk,

Truck / S.U.V. Class Org. or Restored. All Years to 1990

This Class will include Trucks, & S.U.V.,(Suburban, Blazers, Jimmies, Broncos, & Ect.,) that appear to be factory stock. The interior must be original or a duplicate of the original in material, style and color. Engine must be visibly stock for the vehicle's year and model. Numbers do not have to match. No tube-type headers allowed unless proved by original vehicle manufactures.. No bolt-on aftermarket parts allowed. Wheels must be available for the year/ model of the vehicle.

Truck / S.U.V. Class Modified All Years to 1990

All trucks ,S.U.V. ,(Suburban, Blazers, Jimmies, Broncos, & Ect.,) with bolt-on aftermarket or dealer-installed parts and/or accessories. The body may have bolt-on spoilers, ground effects, fiberglass parts, etc. Paint may be of any color from any OEM manufacturer. Aftermarket candy, pearl, metal flake paint entries. Painted pinstripes, and taped pinstripes or decals, and vinyl graphics are allowed. Other items that move an entry to Modified Class include bolt-on headers, ignition wires, air cleaners, valve covers, continental kits, painted engine compartment, etc. Any aftermarket, non stock OEM, multiple carb set-ups, tunnel rams, blowers, turbo chargers and/or late model tuned port-type fuel injection on any other era vehicle. Interiors that are of a custom design that consists of changes to three or more of the following: seats, door panels, dash modifications, flooring, headliner, trunk , and Truck beds.

Late Model Class 1991 to Present.

This class will include all Vehicles (Cars, Trucks, and or S.U.V.) Org. , Restored ,or Modified. Which is manufactured after 1991.
